## FATHER/MOTHER CONSENT FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A PASSPORT IN SOUTH AFRICA

## The following is required:

- 1. The attached Affidavit to be fully completed by the parent residing in New Zealand (affidavit must be signed by a Justice of Peace not older than 3 Months).
- 2. If your DHA office requires fingerprints to be taken, the parent residing in New Zealand will have to come to our office to have this done via an appointment.
- 3. Form DHA-73 to be completed (must be signed by the parent residing in New Zealand).
- 4. Certified copy of South African passport of the parent residing in New Zealand
- 5. A certified copy of the child's passport (not older than 3 months)
- 6. A certified copy of the child's unabridged birth certificate (not older than 3 months)
- 7. A certified copy of the passport of the Father/Mother residing in South Africa (not older than 3 months)
- 8. Affidavit from the Mother/Father in South Africa giving consent to the parent residing in New Zealand to apply for the child's passport
- 9. An e-mail address of an official at the Department of Home Affairs who will accept the application.
- 10. Include a cover letter marked to the attention of Head of Consular Services, with your current contact information and stating that you are applying for a Passport for Minor in SA with one parent
- 11. Once you have all the above kindly email back to wellington.dha@dirco.gov.za
